Curriculum Information for Parents

Autumn Term 2024

Robin Class

India

English

Our English work this term will be closely linked to our topic work about India. We will be inspired by a variety of texts chosen to link with our geography work, both fiction and non-fiction. The children will be encouraged to write in different styles using the knowledge they have gained about India, its people and its animals, using the appropriate use of punctuation and grammar. In addition, we will have daily handwriting and spelling sessions as well as daily guided reading. As ever, the children are encouraged to read at home to help support their development as readers.

Mathematics

We will begin the term by revising and developing our understanding of the number system. We will extend our knowledge of the place value system to three and four-digit numbers and look at ways of calculating mentally and using simple written methods.

In addition to these lessons, we will have a daily mental maths session in which essential facts will be revised and learned, such as number bonds and times tables facts.

Science

The first half of the term will be spent finding out about 'Light'. We will explore how light travels, what reflection is and how shadows are formed. In the second half of the term, we will be looking at 'Electricity' and investigating simple circuits, insulators and conductors and how switches work. Wherever possible, these concepts will be explored using a practical and investigative way of working.

Humanities

Our topic this term is a geography topic and will look at our place in the World and then focus on the country of India. Throughout this topic we will explore the physical and human geography of this fascinating country whilst making comparisons with the U.K. In the second half of the term, our focus will be looking at the diverse culture of India through its music, art and dance.

P.S.H.E. (Personal, Social and Health Education)

We will begin the term by thinking about 'Being Me in my World' in which we develop social skills, cooperation and a sense of pride in our achievements. We will then look at 'Celebrating Difference' in which we consider that everyone is different and that this is our strength as humans. We will look at some of the ways we can solve problems and respond appropriately to social issues such as bullying.

P.E.

This term we will be having two P.E session per week, on Wednesday and Friday. We will begin by using our outdoor space and make use of the better weather to develop skills associated with team games, such as football, netball and tennis. We will then move indoors and explore movement and dance linked to our topic.

Art and Design

We are inspired by our topic for art and design this term and will be exploring the process of printing and using Indian patterns as inspiration for our printed designs.

Design Technology

Our Design technology for this term is food technology. We will be exploring the history and importance of spices to Indian cuisine and then we will design and make our own Indian dish.

Spanish

We continue to receive fantastic support from Mrs Acs for our Spanish lessons throughout the year. We will continue to learn how to describe the weather, our families and pets, as well as how to introduce ourselves.

R.E. This investigation enables pupils to think about how each person is unique and valuable and consider religious beliefs about this. It allows pupils the opportunity to think about groups to which they belong, how some people belong to religious groups and what this means.

I.C.T. and Computing

This term we will be looking at two aspects of computing. We will begin by finding out what a network is and how we communicate with them and how they communicate with us. Then we will find out what a database is and manually demonstrate how information is retrieved.

Music

We are very fortunate to have input from the Shropshire Music Service this term which means Year 3 and 4 will progress to learning to play the PBuzz.
