How to apply for FSM - Shropshire Council

To complete the online application, you will be asked to create an account with Shropshire Council (or sign in if you've already set this up). You will then be able to complete the form, and as part of this you will need to enter your national insurance (NI) number, or, if you are an asylum seeker, your National Asylum Seeker Service (NASS) number.

The qualifying benefits for free school meals are:

- Income support
- Income-based jobseeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of pension credit
- Child tax credit (provided you're not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual grossincome of no more than £16,190)
- Working tax credit run-on paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for working taxcredit. Proof of this will be required
- Universal credit provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, asassessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods

The Department for Education has permanently extended free school meal eligibility to children in all households with no recourse to public funds (NRPF), subject to maximum income thresholds.

If your child has transferred schools within the Shropshire Council local authority area and is in receipt of benefit-related free school meals, you do not need to reapply – the entitlement automatically transfers to the new school.

For children who have transferred to a Shropshire Council area local authority school from an out- of-area school within England, and are in receipt of government (benefit-related) free school meals, please contact us regarding your free school meals claim.

What happens next?

- Your eligibility for government (benefit-related) free school meals will be checked online
- You will be emailed with details of the result. The school that your child/ren attend will also beinformed
- If you qualify for government free school meals a letter will be sent to you to confirm the award
- Entitlement to free school meals cannot be backdated
- If free schools meals entitlement is awarded, please notify us of any changes to your home address
